Unfortunately over 50 years on... SAME SHIT and we're getting ECOLOGICAL BREAKDOWN coming down on us, the only answer is DISOBEY NOW with beautiful ephemeral art with love and revellion in our hearts.

All you need is thin paper for the posters (chip shop paper), thick paper for cutting stencils and emulsion paint etc... then have a workshop and make tons.

## Things you will need

- A4 printer
- Tracing paper
- eraser
- newsprint
- cutting mat
- scalpel handle and 10A scalpel blades
- scissors
- 4" foam rollers and 4" paint trays
- 2B pencil
- masking tape
- 275g paper

Selection of emulsion paint (see [XR colours](#) form the design programme) Recommended paper **275g bread and butter paper**.

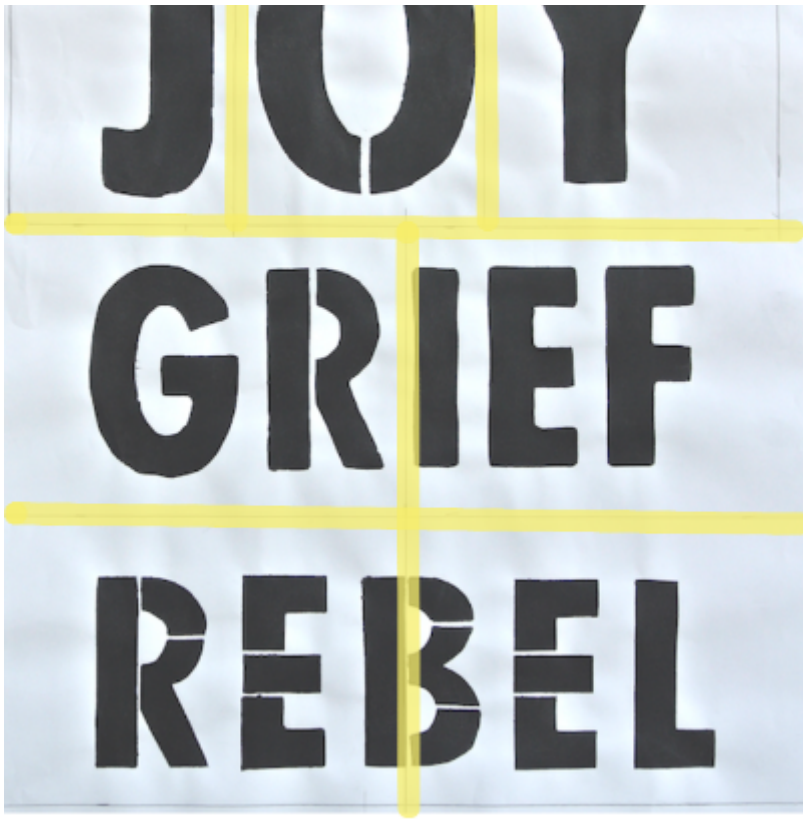
